If your child is interested in learning a musical instrument in 2024 it is not too late. To join the program please register your interest on the P&C's [enrolment page](#).

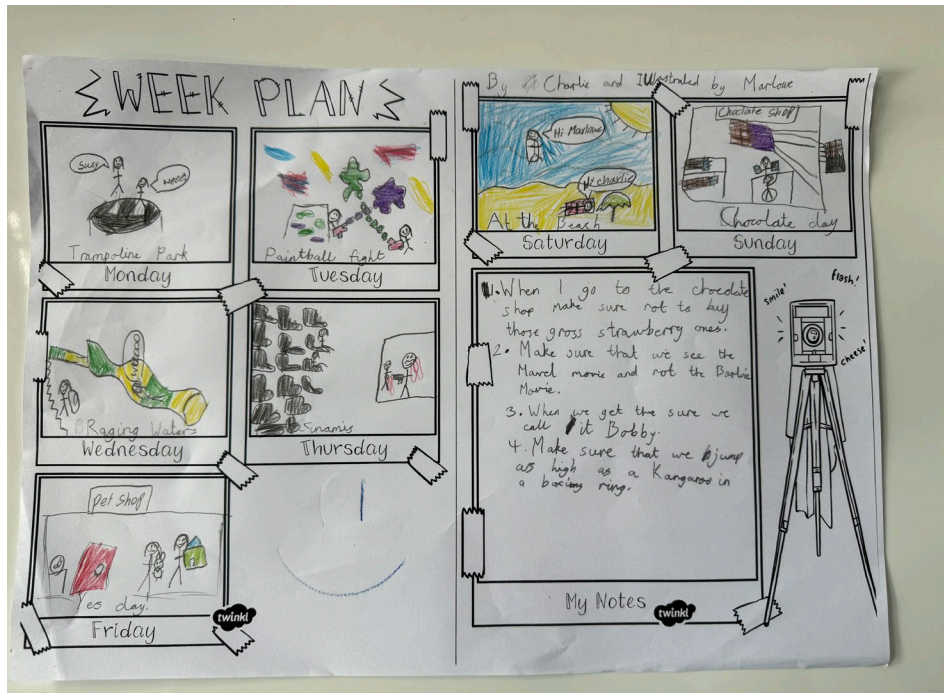
Training strings is commencing in term 2 and there will be a new conductor and a new time. Training strings will now be in the school hall on Monday afternoons from 3:00 pm.

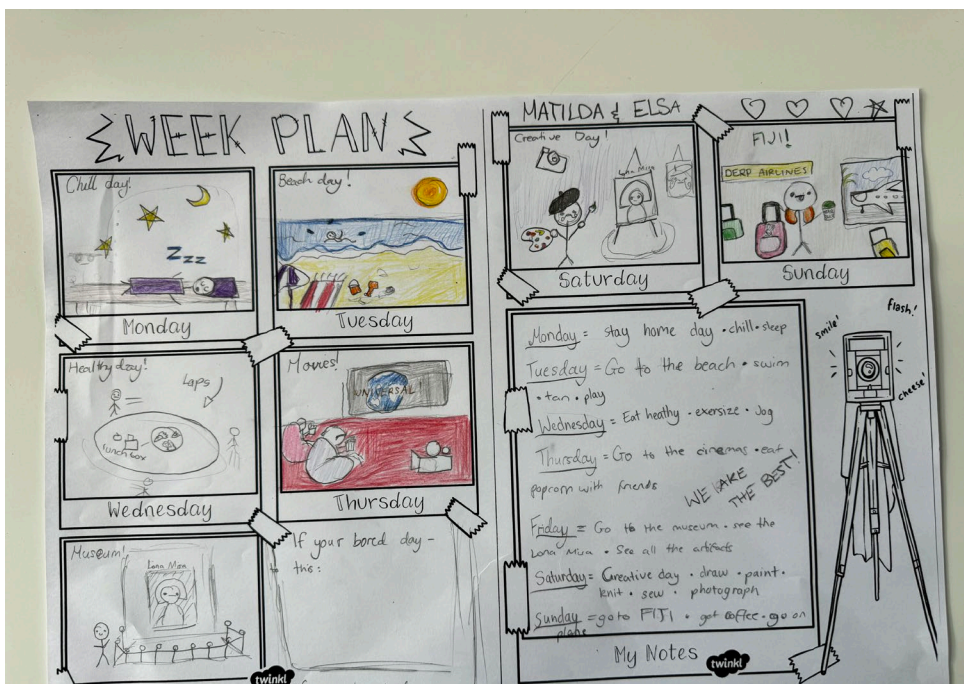


You Can Do It

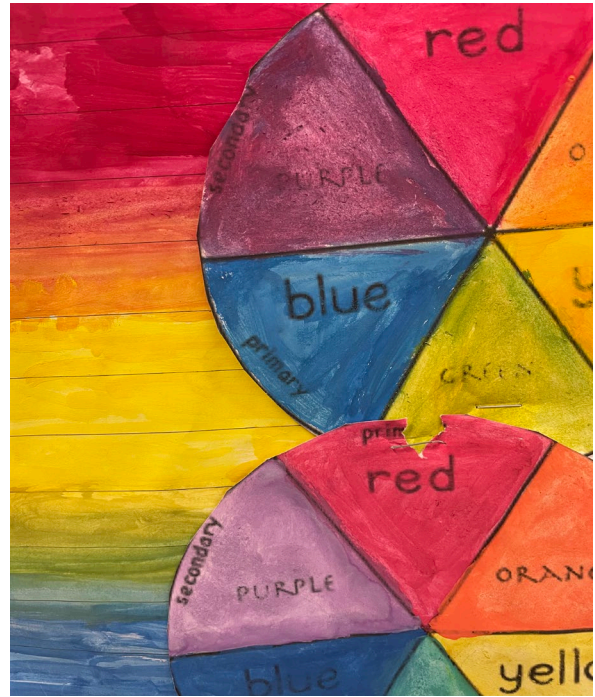

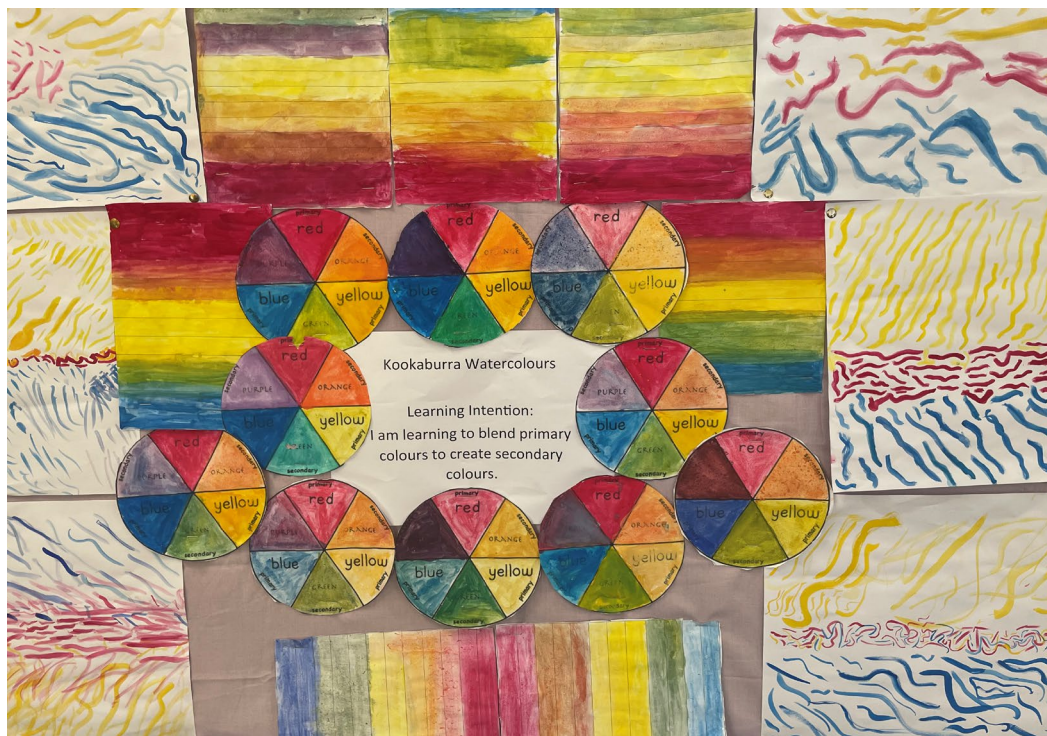

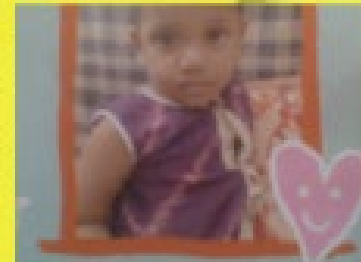
Hi! My name is Aisha!
