Suspension- I have been asked by a parent to let all parents know the Department of Education's policy on physical violence. This is an excerpt from the DET Policy-6.1.5 Principals must suspend immediately and consistently with these procedures, including the factors outlined in 4.0.5 any student who:

 is physically violent. Any student who is physically violent, resulting in pain or injury, or who seriously interferes with the safety and wellbeing of other students, staff or other persons, is to be suspended immediately. The matter may need to be reported to the NSW Police Force.

Note: children 10 years of age and older can be charged by police.

Naplan Unpacked- Thank you to the teachers and parents who attended last night's Naplan session. It is important that the parents have the opportunity to discuss where we are as a school, and what directions we are going in. For any who did not make it to last night's parent meeting, a brief summary is:

- our Reading and Writing results are outstanding, our grammar and punctuation are extremely good.
- Spelling needs a more consistent framework to be developed. Numeracy needs to focus more on some of the basics being taught, to the point that students have that automatic and immediate recall.
- Many of the year 5 students have achieved exceptional growth since year 3.

I have some consultants working with us next year focusing on maths and spelling and developing a whole school approach. Also teachers across all stages are booked in for courses to help teachers further develop classroom skills in mathematics. There should be no surprises when the "My School" website updates in early December as parents already have been given all the information, including last nights' comparison to our local schools that you can't get on the My School website.
