Congratulations, I am looking forward to seeing what you achieve for your fellow students and school in 2012.

Classes for 2012- we still have 15 classes for next year. If you are not returning please in 2012 (and not in Y6) please let the school know now. To put in a demountable costs \$30 000. It is the same amount to remove it if we don't end up with 15 classes. This means \$60 000 would be spent on moving a building instead of educating children. I'm sure you would all be equally concerned about that type of money being wasted rather than being used to benefit children.

There are still a number of families where parents, children or other community members have flagged them as moving on next year, but the school is still waiting to be advised. It is important that limited educational funds are not wasted unnecessarily, please notify the school office if your child will not be here next year, if you have not already done so.

P&C Thank you- I would like to formally thank this year's P&C for all their amazing work and help. They have worked really hard to make sure our school has many extras that directly benefit your children and support the children above what is supplied by the Department and it is through their hard work and dedication that the children have so many advantages. The trumpet and trombone are fairly easy instruments to learn. It only takes a few lessons for children to be able to play a simple tune. They are also versatile instruments that can play classical, jazz or modern music. The euphonium and french horn are more complicated instruments to master, but because they are less common, several private high schools offer scholarships to attract players. The school also offers extended hire for those two instruments. If your child would like to register to learn an instrument, forms are available from the school office. The school can organise tutoring through the school after hours and hires the instruments at a very affordable rate.

The training band is open to all children in third class and older.

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Cool Kids Family Based Program



Cool kids is a program developed by Macquarie University Anxiety Research Unit to help children whose anxiety and fears are interfering with their lives. The program provides an understanding of

anxiety as well as ideas on how to manage anxiety. It is run as a group program where both children and parents attend. Group sessions include presentations, discussions, practical exercises and home practice to help children manage their anxiety. Parents and children will be asked to fill in questionnaires before and after the program.

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
