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Drug Education

This term Ms Gill is teaching Drug Education across K-6.

Students in Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 will learn about:

- The purpose of medicines
- The appropriate use and storage of medicines
- Discuss dangerous or hazardous products around the house that should be kept out of reach of children
- Learn what to do in an emergency situation

Students in Stage 2 and Stage 3 will learn about:

- The effects of alcohol and smoking on the body, community and the environment
- Why people choose to drink and smoke
- How to respond to situations where they may encounter people drinking or smoking
- Brainstorm what they can do if they feel uncomfortable around someone drinking or smoking
- Discuss attitudes and opinions towards drug use
- Legal and Illegal drugs
